SOUTH SIDE MARKET STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT: BID AWARD

Cl'm Halstead explained the Sidewalk Project bid cost difference.

C R Charles Excavating: Bid = \$33,208.00. Cement cost per unit = \$99.00 Glenn Halbaker: Bid = \$112,789.00. Cement cost per unit = \$350.00

Engineer Phil Brath had reviewed both sets of bid documents and confirmed the bids were in compliance.

MOTION: Cl'm Halstead moved, seconded by Cl'm Shope to award the South Side Market Street Sidewalk Project bid to C R Charles Excavating for \$33,208.00. Motion carried unanimously.

NORTH SIDE MARKET STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT: Cl'm Halstead

There is \$22,790.00 left in the grant. She confirmed with DEDA-COG that the 2 projects cannot be combined, and the North Side Market Street Sidewalk Project will need to be advertised as a separate bid. This bid cannot be awarded until 10 days after the second advertisement, which would be Friday, October 6, 2023 at 8:30 am. If a quorum of Council is present, the bid could be awarded the same day.

MOTION: Cl'm Fickes moved, seconded by Cl'm Shope to Advertise for Bids for the North Side Market Street Project. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: Cl'm Halstead moved, seconded by Cl'm Fickes to Approve the 2024 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) of Zero Dollars (\$0) for Uniform Pension. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: Cl'm Halstead moved, seconded by Cl'm Shope to Approve the 2024 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) of Eight Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$8,473.00) for Non-Uniform Pension. Motion carried unanimously.

Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance - Trucks on Walnut Street: Cl'm Fickes

A Dollar General tractor trailer hit a resident's truck on Walnut Street. No Trucks signs are not presently located on 6th & Walnut Street. The current ordinance will be reviewed. No Action taken.

MOTION: Cl'm Halstead moved, seconded by Cl'm Zentichko to Approve the Payment to Citizen's Fire Company No. 1 in the amount of \$19,126.32 for Fire Protection. Motion carried unanimously.
