ORDINANCE NO. 389

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 368 RELATING TO THE
TICKETING ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWPORT, TO SET FINES BY
RESOLUTION.**

WHEREAS the Borough of Newport is a body corporate and political, duly organized, and existing in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Borough Code, PA C.S. Title 8, §101 et seq. (Borough Code), and

WHEREAS the Borough Council of the Borough of Newport has determined that amendments to this ordinance are necessary; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Newport the following amendments to Ordinance 368, Section IV:

SECTION IV. PROCESS FOR ISSUING VIOLATION TICKETS

D. Amended to read as follows:

If the violation is not addressed to the satisfaction of the code enforcement officer within five (5) days from the issuance of the Notice of Violation, the code enforcement officer shall issue a first Notice of Violation Ticket to the violator consistent with the service of process described in (B) 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, above in Section IV. The first Notice of Violation Ticket shall be in writing and shall identify the property address (if applicable), include a statement of the violation(s), specify the maximum time frame to take corrective action to address the violation(s), and detail the fine for the non-payment of the ticket within the prescribed time frame. The fine for the first Notice of Violation shall be set from time to time by resolution.

E. Amended to read as follows:

If the violation is not addressed to the satisfaction of the code enforcement officer within five (5) days after the issuance of the first Notice of Violation Ticket, the code enforcement officer shall issue a second Notice of Violation Ticket. The fine for the second Notice of Violation shall be set from time to time by resolution. If the violation is not addressed within five (5) days of the issuance of the second Notice of Violation Ticket, a third Notice of Violation Ticket shall be issued. The fine for the third Notice of Violation Ticket shall be set from time to time by resolution.
